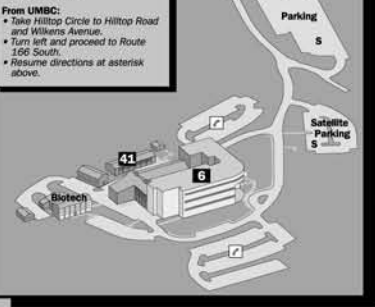

 • Road immediately forks.  
 • Take left fork and proceed a half mile to entrance.

**From UMBC:**  
 • Take Hilltop Circle to Hilltop Road and Wilkens Avenue.  
 • Turn left and proceed to Route 166 South.  
 • Resume directions at asterisk above.
